

Quarter 3 History Project! DUE MARCH 4th!

Create a **timeline** of the events significant to **World War Two**.

You will create a time line of the major events in World War Two.

You **do not** have to include pictures, but you are encouraged to.

You can do this by PowerPoint, or you can complete on a word document. We will be reviewing all of these events in class during Unit 9

You must include the following 15 major events listed below(next page) on your timeline. They **are not in order**. You must put them in order and write a brief description of the event, **IN YOUR OWN WORDS** with a minimum of 2 complete sentences **and** a date, month/ year. **You may add more if you would like!** Each correctly described event written in 2 or more complete sentences, using appropriate spelling, capitalization, and punctuation will be awarded 5 points for a total of 75 points, 25 points will be awarded to the ordering of the events, for a grand total of 100 points.

This is how you will be graded!

Descriptions (5 points (below) x 15 = 75 points)

- ✓ 3 points for each correct description written in the students own words.
- ✓ 2 points for evidence of revision (correct spelling/ capitalization/ punctuation)

Correct sequencing of the Events 25 points

25 points	Zero mistakes
20 points	2 mistakes
15 points	3-5 mistakes
5 points	6-8 mistakes
0 points	8 or more mistakes

Describe each of the 15 events on next page and put them in order. Here is an example of what your description should look like.

Suppose my event was, Germany takes over France. (This really happened in the war, but, it is not an event listed on your timeline). My time line description would look like this/ or similar to this. Make sure to include *event title, date, and minimum of two sentences* as shown in the example below.

EXAMPLE: Germany Takes over France (*event title*) **May 1940** (*date*) Germany has marched through Poland and other countries as democracies stood by and did nothing. Now Germany has invaded France. This is a huge turning point in the war. Countries that were once reluctant/ afraid to enter the war were left with no choice. Hitler was clearly not stopping. (*Minimum of 2 sentences describing the event*)

I added more above to this example. You are only **required 2 sentences, and the date! Some of them you may only have two things to write. But, I want to encourage you to write more. This assignment will be very beneficial when taking the tests and quizzes as well! **
